

Nil Ashal writes a piece of Nile Arabians breeding history at the racetrack of Meissenheim, October 16th 2011

The 3-year old stallion Nil Ashal (Nil Bedouin x Nil Abiat v. Darike) won easily over 1'800 meter in the "Preis der Rennsportfreunde Meissenheim" giving his debut on the race track.

Not his win as a debutant is legendary but Nil Ashal put a new milestone of Nile breeding in place. In our 35-year old breeding history, Nil Ashal is the first horse where both of his parents are Nile bred. At the same time Nil Ashal is Nil Bedouin's first foal on the race track (Barour de Cardonne x Nil Tahani) and the first winner at his first start.

The sire Nil Bedouin is black typed with Group II and Group III places and a total of four wins. Nil Ashal's mother Nil Abiat (Darike x Kadjouna de Nerak by Djourman) originates from actually one of the most successful French dam lines with recent Group winners like Al Tair, Aziz ASF, Dubai Heros and Al Anqa, all Amer descendants.
