

Endurance mare Kahrma goes for the first time over 90 kilometers in Italy, August 9th 2012

At July 29th 2012 our former racing mare Kahrma (Dormane x Kahloucha) was placed 8th in a CEN/b endurance race over 90 kilometers in Vattoro, Italy, racing for the first time over this distance.

On the last lap, 7-year old Kahrma was the fastest horse in the field and she passed the final vet. check in an excellent metabolic condition. Her owner and rider Vincenzo Ambruzzese was satisfied commenting her performance after the race: "Kahrma is a real race horse and at the end of the race she was able to speed up".

Kahrma was the first foal out of our Tunisian bred and Group III winning mare Kahloucha, 1998 (Zeidoun x Zannouche). Kahrma is bred by Dormane (Manganate x Mandore), a sire of influence in France and worldwide for race and endurance breeding.

As a 3- and 4-year old, Kahrma was placed 7 times out of 9 international starts. Currently here full brother Nil Karazi, born 2007, is on the race track, too. He was a winner as a 3-year old and placed 7 times out of 8 starts at the age of four. We think that Nil Karazi has a lot of potential for the endurance sport in the future and we hope to find an experienced endurance rider and trainer to develop him in endurance after his racing career.
