

Nil Aziz is challenging the Italian racing elite, Pisa 26th of March

After his superior Listed win in St. Moritz on February 12th, Nil Aziz is again successful one month later in Pisa. Ridden by Tim Bürgin the Dahess son wins with top weight the Prix Domus de Janas, an international race over 1'900 meters at the beautiful Italian race track San Rossore.

There were some of the best Italian horses competing in the Prix Domus de Janas. Tornado Byzucchele, Lares de Pine and French bred Yenka were the horses to beat. Nil Aziz had to carry top weight of 62 kg due to his Listed win in St. Moritz.

Tim Bürgin was riding Nil Aziz during the whole race behind the leaders on the outside. At the 300 m mark Nil Aziz attacked the leading Munjiz daughter Yenka and second runner Tornado Byzucchele. At the finishing line Nil Aziz won by a short head in front Yenka who was carrying 9.5 kilo less than Nil Aziz. On third place followed Tornado Byzucchele by 2 1/4 lengths.

It was Nil Aziz's third win in his young career. He is following the footsteps of his half-brother Nil Ashal by Nil Bedouin, an 8-times winner and black type horse.
