
HANIDA, winner in the PRIX DE LA CHAPELLE-LA-REINE at Fontainebleau, 16th of April 2021

The 5-year old thoroughbred mare HANIDA is the winner of the Handicap Divisé over 2'600 meters with a donation of € 16'000.-. The FRENCH FIFTEEN daughter out of the PIVOTAL mother FOSOOL showed a brave performance in a field of 17 horses. She was ridden by Frida Valle Skar in the colours of Therese Reusser and trained by Franziska Aeschbacher.

On March 14th, **HANIDA** gave her season start in a handicap over 2'200 meters in Angoulême. Ridden by our stable jockey Kerry Raybould, she finished 7th in a field of 15 horses. One month later she was ready to win with Frida Valle Skar in the saddle over 2'600 meters in Fontainebleau. Actually, the mare has a race record of 2 wins and 9 places out of 16 starts in France. Breeder of **HANIDA** is the Haras de Victot owned by H.H. Cheikh Abdullah Bin Khalifa Al Thani from Qatar.
