
Nil Kamla's last foal, Kamun du Nil, 23rd of April 2021

Three days after the birth of her third foal Kamun du Nil, Nil Kamla died abruptly at the age of 10 years. Her death leaves a hole in our breeding. Fortunately we found a nurse mare who perfectly adopted the colt.

Three days after birth, Nil Kamla showed a certain indisposition. Despite the immediate action of the experienced veterinarian, her state of health worsened within short time and four hours later she had to be euthanized. The reason of her death was an internal bleeding.

Before **Nil Kamla** (Dahess x Kahloucha) started her breeding career, she was a successful race horse. At the age between 3- and 5-years she raced 12 times, was winning 2 races and placed 9 times. With her win of the **Sheikh Zayed Bin Sultan Al Nahyan Listed Cup** (Listed PA) at St. Moritz 2016, she reached black type status.

Beside her last foal **Kamun du Nil** by **Al Mamun Monlau**, Nil Kamla leaves two other offspring, the firstborn filly **Kiss du Nil** (2018) by **Assy** and the 2020 born **Khan du Nil** by **No Risk al Maury**.

Fortunately we could find for **Kamun du Nil** a nurse mare. It is the Norman mare Queeny who has now with **Kamun du Nil** her 4th adopted foal.

Kamun du Nil's father **Al Mamun Monlau** (Munjiz x Salalah de Monlau v. Tidjani) is still a young sire who produced already some black type progeny. 2019 he had his first 3-year olds on the track and was in the same year leading sire of the 3-year old's in France. **Al Mamun Monlau** and **Nil Kamla** are both out of the same Tunisian dam line tracing back to the foundation mare **Samaria**.
