
First podium for MISS HONEYMOON, Wissembourg 14th May 2023

Homebred 3-years old thoroughbred filly MISS HONEYMOON finished third over 2400m in a maiden race in Wissembourg.

In the Prix **GROUPAMA**, a maiden race for 3-yrs old over the distance of 2400m and dotated with a prize money of Euros 10'000, **MISS HONEYMOON** (Olympic Glory x Miss Spirit by Spirit One) run all way long in last position, quickened up after the last turn and finished with good speed on the third place. After having been two times fourth in Saint-Galmier and in Royan, this is her third place out of four races in 2023 so far.

MISS HONEYMOON belongs to the first generation born at our new stud farm **Haras du Nil** in France. Already her dam **MISS SPIRIT** (Spirit One x Miss Lloyds by Take Risks) was trained by Franziska Aeschbacher during her race career from 2 years old to 5 years old. **MISS SPIRIT** is a 4-times winner in Switzerland and France. In Switzerland she won the **OAKS**, had been 3rd in the **1000 Guineas** and the **Prix de Diane**.

MISS SPIRIT had been bred again in 2022, this time by the stallion **HELLO YOUZAIN** (Kodiac x Spasha by Shamardal) and gave birth to a filly in February this year.
