
Two races, two wins for KAMUN DU NIL, Mons-Ghlin 8th of October 2024

One month after his win for his debut, the 3-yrs gelding KAMUN DU NIL wins again, this time with 6 lengths, ridden by the French jockey Stéphane Laurent. In the same race, the AHRCB JUNIOR CUP II for 3- and 4-year-old horses over the distance of 1500m, his stablemate BETTERLOVE AL ASHAI, owned by Kamal Al Bahou, ridden by the Belgian Jockey Christophe Dehens finishes third. Both horses are trained by Franziska Aeschbacher at the Haras du Nil.

When doing his first race out one month ago, **KAMUN DU NIL** (Al Mamun Monlau x Nil Kamla by Dahess) was figuring as an outsider. After his easy win the betters had an eye on him and his betting odds was 1 : 1,1 which made him the clear favorite.

Coming out of the last gate, **KAMUN DU NIL** took his responsibilities and the lead before the first bend, followed by the good 4 yrs mare **KADIRA DE CROATE** (AF Albahar x Emeraude Du Croate by Dahess), a Listed placed horse in France. Stéphane Laurent controlled the race on **KAMUN DU NIL** and waited for the attacks of the concurrents. When **KADIRA DU CROATE** tried to catch up beginning the straight line, **KAMUN DU NIL** accelerated easily and won with 6 lengths in front of **KADIRA DU CROATE**.
