
Good end of season for KAMUN DU NIL on Group III level,
Toulouse 31st of October 2024

At the end of the season there is a final Group race, the Prix CHERI BIBI (GR.3 PA) for 3-year old colts in Toulouse where normally some of the best 3-year old compete to finish their season. Our 3-year old gelding KAMUN DU NIL, bred, raised and trained at the HARAS DU NIL, was coming to Toulouse with two wins out of two races in Belgium. For KAMUN DU NIL it was his first race in France and for the first time on turf. He was fighting courageously and finished the race half a length and a short neck behind the podium on fifth place.

Seven colts were starting in the **Prix Cheri Bibi (GR.3 PA)**. As usual the horses came from renowned stables and French trainers such as F. Rohaut, T. Fourcy or X. Thomas-Demeaulte. Four of the seven horses are owned by important owners from the Gulf region.

For **KAMUN DU NIL** (Al Mamun Monlau x Nil Kamla by Dahess) it was an interesting test to see how he is competing against this quality of horses. In Belgium he achieved his two wins in lower category races and on a fast dirt track on which he felt very comfortable also because of his pedigree. Toulouse was now his first race on turf with deep ground (4.2).

After the start his rider Stéphane Laurent placed him on second position, where he stayed until the bend, In the bend he lost some of his rhythm at the outside in the deep ground and lost some places. On the last 400 meters he was fighting in good style and finished the race on fifth place only half a length and a short neck behind the third place.

Winner was the colt **LINO** (AF Albahar x Ezza v. Kerbella), bred and owned by Yannick Schulz and trained by Eric Dell'ova

KAMUN DU NIL was with his 2 wins and a Group III place out of three starts the most successful horse in our stable in 2024. In Belgium he won the title of the best 3-year old horse and in France he has now a handicap of 43. He will enjoy his winter holidays on the pasture for the next 2 or 3 months.

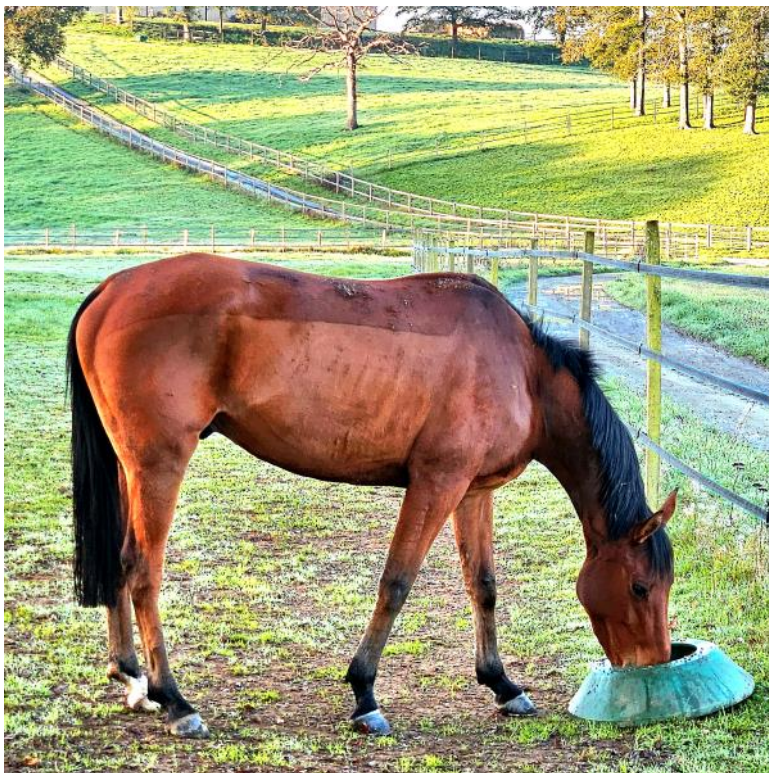
